

Dear Parents,

Online Safety Update

We have recently had several incidents of children in school feeling unsafe online as part of WhatsApp groups and/or when using the app 'TikTok.' These incidents have all happened outside of school but have led to upset and distress in school. Please can you make sure that you are monitoring your child's use of social media, ensuring that their activity online is age appropriate and responsible. We are running extra circle times in KS2 over the next few weeks with a focus on peer pressure; how to stay safe and be responsible / respectful online; awareness of the effects of social media.

In/Out of School

Pokemon Cards: A reminder that children can bring their Pokemon cards into school on Wednesdays. Miss Rainbow is running a 'Pokemon Trade and Swap Shop' from 12.30-1pm. School Car Park: Please note that the school car park should only be used by parents dropping off and collecting children from Marazion Oasis Childcare Centre. Please note that staff are now manning the school drive at the start and end of the school day to ensure the safety of parents and pupils. September 2022 Reception Transition: Transition sessions for our new September 2022 Reception continue next Wednesday 13th July from 9.00 - 10.30am. After that, the next transition will be on Friday 22nd July 9.00-11.00am where all parents and children are invited to attend. If parents and children would like to stay for a buffet lunch (£1 per person), please let the School Office know by Friday 15th July. The final transition session will be a group session on Monday 25th July. School Visits: Southgate are visiting Marazion Beach on Thursday 14th July to explore habitats and to take part in a Beach Clean. Children are also practising their new volleyball skills. Please can children wear their own clothes and bring sun cream, a sun hat and a refillable water bottle. Thanks. Children are back in school for normal pick up time. Forest Fridays: Please note that Forest Fridays may sometimes include Beach School. Children and adults wear comfortable clothes on Fridays, that they do not mind getting dirty, whether they are taking part in Woodland or Beach School. Headlice - Treatment and Prevention

Please can you check your child's hair for headlice at least once a week. This is important in order to make sure that the source of infection is always managed. Local expert advice supports treatment with the Wet Combing Method - at least a weekly check of wet hair at hair wash time to detect headlice using a good quality detection comb and any conditioner. If live lice are detected this method should be used every 3 days for 2-3 weeks in order to prevent re-infection. If you find someone in your family has headlice, it is important to inform all close contacts. Thanks.

We want to keep doing this, so every week one class (or the whole school) will choose who they want to say thank you to.
