

Is My Child Too Ill for School?

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school when they're unwell. There are government guidelines for schools (and nurseries) about <u>managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK</u>. These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. A reminder that, if you do keep your child at home, you must phone school on each day of their absence and let us know that your child won't be in school and give us the reason. PE and School Sport
