Safeguarding Awareness for Parents & Carers

How OFSTED Inspects Safeguarding: A reminder about recent training around how Ofsted inspect safeguarding, inspectors were clear that schools are only a part of the system that is in place to keep children safe and that 'schools cannot be everything to everyone.' For example, they recognise that school leaders are not trained social workers. Ofsted are clear that they have no intention of trying to 'catch schools out on technicalities'. Ofsted does not expect anything from schools beyond that which is set out in 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' (KCSIE) documents and their school policies and protocols. Ofsted are very much looking for a culture of safeguarding - they 'expect all schools to have an open and positive culture around safeguarding that put pupils' interests first'. Inspectors will use a range of evidence to evaluate the effectiveness of safeguarding arrangements. Ofsted say that an important aspect of inspection and safeguarding is to be assured that the school is 'reflective and receptive to challenge' and that staff understand that safeguarding is an 'ongoing endeayour'.
