


MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 17th March 2023

In/Out of School

Marazion School Reading Room (RR): Children can choose to come into school and read for pleasure from 8.30-8.45am every day. Notting Hill are hosting sessions next week. School Events: Forest Fridays (FFs): Adults and children wear comfortable clothes that they do not mind getting dirty on Fridays. These clothes must also be suitable for working outside. School Visits: School visit information is sent to parents by email from their child's class teacher.

PE and School Sport

Spring PE Days: Bristol Bus (Year R/1): Monday and Thursday; Notting Hill (Year 1/2): Monday and Thursday; Invictus (Year 3/4): Tuesday and Wednesday; Clement's Inn (Year 5): Monday and Wednesday; Stonewall (Year 6): Monday and Wednesday. Fixtures and Events: Year 3&4 Sports Hall Athletics at MBA 9.30-11.45, letters have gone out to selected children. Boys Year 5&6 Football Festival at MBA 3.30-5pm, letters have gone out to selected children. Team training for girls and boys in KS2 continues in school on Tuesdays and Thursdays (weather dependent). Swimming Sessions: This half term some children in Years 3, 4 and 6 are going swimming - this includes our 'continuing swimmers.' If your child is going swimming, you will receive a text message to confirm that they are swimming the day before (Tuesday). Pupils need swimming kit (black costume or trunks - not board shorts) and goggles (if you have them) as well as a £1 contribution towards the cost of the sessions. School provides swimming caps. Thanks. There is a LATER pick up @ 4pm for children who are swimming. Gym Sessions: Bristol Bus (BB) are going to Penzance Gym this term. Please can children in BB come to school in their PE kit on Mondays. A reminder that all children need to wear a t-shirt that has no buttons to the gym. Thanks. Optional PE Homework: For March homework, we would like you to create a healthy breakfast. Please draw and label your breakfast and let Mr Tanner have the picture of a yummy start to the day.
