


MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 14th March 2024

Spring Term Parents' Meetings

Payment for Breakfast Club and School Lunches

Please note that payment for school lunches and for Breakfast Club must be paid in advance. The cost of a school lunch is £2.65 per day (£13.25 for the week). The cost of Breakfast Club is £1 per day and free for pupil premium children. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 are eligible for universal free school meals, which means that every child can have a free school meal (FSM). Some children in KS2 are eligible for FSM. Please contact Tamsyn in the School Office if you think that your family may be eligible for FSM. Texts will now be sent on Fridays if there is any debt against either school lunches or Breakfast Club or both. Thank you for your support with this.

In/Out of School

<u>Marazion Clubs</u>: Please note that spring Marazion Clubs continue every week for this half term. Marazion School Reading Room (RR): Children can choose to come into school and read for pleasure from 8.30-8.45am every day. Rivers are hosting reading sessions next week. Safeguarding Awareness for Parents & Carers

We have a cybersecurity question for you this week: What is the meaning of phishing, smishing, vishing and quishing? See below for more information:

Phishing - a malicious email encouraging you to click on a link with the aim of collecting your details or downloading malicious code; **Smishing** - a text message (SMS) to encouraging you to click on a link with the aim of collecting your details or transferring you to a fake website; **Vishing** - an unsolicited telephone call to collect your details or defraud you; **Quishing** - a fake QR code diverting you to a fake website or some other fraudulent link.
