


# MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 9th March 2023

Dear Parents,

This week we have had Parents' Meetings for our residential visits to Camp Kernow for Year 5 and the National Marine Aquarium in Plymouth for Years 3 and 4. Thank you to so many of you who joined us on Zoom to find out more about both adventures. If you were unable to make the Zoom meeting, please contact your child's class teacher for further information. A reminder of cost of the visits: £90 for children in Invictus, with school paying for the coach fare and a capped cost of £150 for children in Clements' Inn. We felt that it was important to support the cost of the residential visits this year (from Marazion School fundraising) due to the current economic situation. Please note that there is a subsidy available for pupil premium children – please speak to Ed or Laura in the School Office for more information. Children in Clements' Inn are fundraising for March and April starting with Easter biscuits, which will be on sale after school on Friday 31st March from 1.30pm and also during our Spring Open Afternoon on Thursday 23rd March.

Swimming Sessions: This half term some children in Years 3, 4 and 6 are going swimming - this includes our 'continuing swimmers.' If your child is going swimming, you will receive a text message to confirm that they are swimming the day before (Tuesday). Pupils need swimming kit (black costume or trunks - not board shorts) and goggles (if you have them) as well as a £1 contribution towards the cost of the sessions. School provides swimming caps.
