In/Out of School

Marazion School Reading Room (RR): Children can choose to come into school and read for pleasure from 8.30-8.45am every day. Stonewall are hosting the sessions next week. Marazion School Uniform: Children need to wear school uniform/PE uniform Monday to Thursday. Our school uniform is a white t-shirt/polo shirt/shirt with dark (grey/black) joggers/trousers/shorts /skirts/pinafores with a school jumper/cardigan. Our PE uniform is similar - white t-shirt with dark joggers/shorts and warmer layers for autumn/winter PE Days. Children also need to wear black comfortable shoes/trainers for PE Days. Forest Fridays (FFs): Adults and children wear comfortable clothes that they do not mind getting dirty on Fridays. These clothes must also be suitable for working outside. School Visits: School visit information is sent to parents by email from their child's class teacher.

Spring PE Days: Please note changes. Bristol Bus (Year R/1): Thursday; Notting Hill (Year 1/2): Monday and Thursday; Invictus (Year 3/4): Tuesday and Wednesday; Clement's Inn (Year 5): Monday and Wednesday; Stonewall (Year 6): Monday and Wednesday. Fixtures and Events: Team training for girls and boys in KS2 continues in school on Tuesdays and Thursdays (weather dependent). Next week some Year 5/6 girls are taking part in a Girls' Football Festival @ MBA. Letters have already gone out. See below for date and time. Swimming Sessions: Some children in Year 4, 5 and 6 are swimming on Wednesday afternoons this half term. If your child is one of those, you will receive a text message to confirm that they are swimming on the Tuesday before. Pupils need swimming kit (black costume or trunks - not board shorts) and goggles (if you have them) as well as a £1 contribution towards the cost of the sessions. School provides swimming caps. Thanks. There is a LATER pick up @ 4pm for children who are swimming. Gym Sessions: Children in Clement's Inn are at Penzance Gym on Mondays this half term. Please can children come to school in their PE kit on Mondays. A reminder that all children need to wear a t-shirt that has no buttons to the gym. Thanks. Optional PE Homework: For February homework, we would like you to try a new sport or activity which can be inside or outside of school. Why not go for a short brisk walk; take part in a Joe Wicks workout twice a week: do a beach clean?
