Dear Parents,

Sunny weather is still here so we have again attached our Sun Protection Policy electronically to this newsletter. Please can you review it, if you haven't already. Thanks. Please note that ideally children should have access to their own **named** sunhat in school during the spring and summer months and a wide-brimmed hat that covers the face, neck and ears. Children are encouraged to apply sunscreen before school starts with a UVA protection of 4 stars or above and sun protection factor (SPF) of at least 30. Children are encouraged to bring in sun cream for application at lunchtime and school visits. Please also note that staff will apply sunscreen to children as and when is necessary. This includes both in school **and** on school visits. Parents must inform the school if they do not want a staff member to apply sunscreen.

Summer Marazion Book Day - NEXT Thursday 15th June

On Thursday 15th June we have our summer Marazion Book Day. This year we are being inspired by the newest *Mr. Men* and *Little Miss* characters, **Mr Calm and Little Miss Brave**. They join the 90-strong line-up in the book series by Roger Hargreaves after a global public vote to name new members in celebration of the brand's 50th anniversary. Marazion School Playing field: Please note that the playing field is an area that is **OUT OF BOUNDS** for **ALL** dogs at **ALL** times. Many thanks. **Swiss Assistant Teachership - June 2023**: Janine Abegg is now in school on student placement from the University of Zurich, working for 3 weeks as part of the class team in Invictus. **Marazion School Reading Room (RR)**: Children can choose to come into school and read for pleasure from 8.30-8.45am every day. Bristol Bus are hosting reading sessions next week. **School Events: FUNKY Forest Fridays (FFs)**: We are currently trialing some changes to our afternoon KS2 Forest Friday sessions to make them more funky. Children will again work in vertical groups (Year 3 to Year 6) taking part in 6 sessions over 6 weeks in the autumn term. This half term, while we finalise the new Funky Forest Fridays, children still need to wear comfortable outdoor clothes that they do not mind getting dirty on Fridays. **School Events**: Staff and children from MBA are now visiting Year 5 children next week to discuss life at secondary school and NH have a LEAP Dance workshop. **School Visits**: There are no school visits next week. PE and School Sport

Marazion School Clubs: A reminder that Marazion clubs continue after half term until Friday 7th July. Please note that the Year 6 Sailing Club has started but is weather dependent. Children were not able to sail this week due to the wind conditions. Fixtures and Events: Team training for girls and boys in KS2 continues in school on Tuesdays and Thursdays (weather dependent). Next week some children in KS2 are taking part in the Penwith Primary Schools Athletics event @ Carn Brea running track. This is an all-day event and letters have already been handed out.
