# In/Out of School

Marazion School Reading Room (RR): Children can choose to come into school and read for pleasure from 8.30-8.45am every day. Clement's Inn are hosting reading sessions during the first week back. Out of School Celebrations: Every week during Celebration Assembly, we celebrate the wonderful things that children have completed outside of school. This could be moving up a stage in swimming; getting a badge in Brownies or Scouts; being man/woman of the match. If your child has something to share, they can celebrate it on Thursdays with all of us. Year 6 Homework: A reminder that Year 6 children have extra homework in order to prepare them for secondary school - set weekly or byweekly basis. There is also a homework lunchtime session with Mr Groom the week prior to the homework deadline. Homework is given both on paper and on Seesaw and details of the homework and the deadline are in their homework diaries. Please can you remind your child and check if they have homework due. Thanks. School Events: Notting Hill (NH) LEAP Dance Project: NH are taking part in a dance session in school during the first week back as part of the LEAP Dance Project, which they are involved in. Forest Fridays (FFs): Adults and children wear comfortable clothes that they do not mind getting dirty on Fridays. These clothes must also be suitable for working outside. School Visits: School visit information is sent to parents by email from their child's class teacher. During the first week back Notting Hill are launching their summer term learning with a dinosaur hunt in the woods.

# PE and School Sport

Summer PE Days: Bristol Bus (Year R/1): Monday and Thursday; Notting Hill (Year 1/2): Monday and Thursday; Invictus (Year 3/4): Tuesday and Wednesday; Clement's Inn (Year 5): Monday and Wednesday; Stonewall (Year 6): Monday and Wednesday. Fixtures and Events: After half term, team training for girls and boys in KS2 continues in school on Tuesdays and Thursdays (weather dependent). There are no fixtures and events during the first week back. Swimming Sessions: This half term some children in Years 3, 4 and 6 are going swimming - this includes our 'continuing swimmers'. If your child is going swimming, you will receive a text message to confirm that they are swimming the day before (Tuesday). Pupils need swimming kit (black costume or trunks - not board shorts) and goggles (if you have them) as well as a £1 contribution towards the cost of the sessions. School provides swimming caps.
