Marazion School Breakfast Club

Another reminder that Breakfast Club (BC) at Marazion School starts at 7.45am. You must complete a consent form before your child/children start BC. These forms are available from the school office. Please note that the cost of Breakfast Club is £1 and is now the same for children who eat breakfast in school and children who are dropped off at Breakfast Club. We also ask that you pay promptly. Places in BC must also be paid for in advance or may be paid for on the day. Please note that you can pay for the week/month/term ahead either with cash or by BACS. If you are paying by BACS, please make sure that you have your child's/children's names as well as 'Breakfast Club' as the reference. Please note that BC is free for pupil premium children.
