


MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 28th September 2023

Dear Parents,

A reminder that Breakfast Club (BC) at Marazion School starts at 7.45am. Children can come into school to have breakfast together and enjoy toast; cereals; yoghurt; fruit and orange/apple juice. You must complete a consent form before your child/children start BC. These forms are available from the school office. Please note that the cost of Breakfast Club is £1. We also ask that you pay promptly. Places in BC must also be paid for in advance or may be paid for on the day. Texts have already been sent as reminders for anyone who is not up to date with payment for BC. You can pay for the week/month/term ahead either with cash or by BACS. If you are paying by BACS, please make sure that you have your child's/children's names as well as 'Breakfast Club' as the reference. Please note that BC is free for pupil premium children.

Early Years Reading Meeting (Reception/ KS1) - Monday 2nd October

Parents of children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 are invited to an Early Years Reading Meeting (EYRM) on Monday 2nd October from 2.30-3.30pm. Parents can watch a live phonics session, which is followed by a meeting from 2.50pm to find out more about how we teach reading at Marazion School. A live phonics session will also be posted on Seesaw. We have a later EYRM at 5pm via Zoom - the Zoom invite will be sent out from your child's class teacher. Please let Mrs Stedmon or Miss Hall know which EYRM you would like to attend. Thanks.

Year 6 Taster Days - NEXT WEEK - Humphry Davy School (HDS) Mounts Bay Academy (MBA) HDS and MBA are both having taster days next week. MBA Open Day is on Tuesday 3rd October and HDS Open Day is Thursday 5th October. Parents of Year 6 children should have already received information from HDS about their day. For both days, Year 6 need to be at school EARLY for 7.45am in school uniform. Lunch is being provided for both days but children can bring their own packed lunch if they prefer. Children will be back in school for 3pm. Please note that after school clubs will be on as normal.

Nasal Flu Vaccination 2023

Reminder that permissions need to be completed online before midday NEXT Tuesday 3^{rd} October in order for your child to obtain a vaccine. Flu vaccinations are being given in school on Friday 6^{th} October.
