Equipment Needed

Clement's Inn Curriculum Information Spring Term 2023



This term's learning is all about Empire Key Question: Is Hope and Glory Important?

Our topic for this term is *Empire* which is a history-based topic. Our topic launch is a trip to Bodmin Jail where the children will learn about how the jail was used in the Victorian Era.

Literacy - This term the children will write a newspaper report based on our launch day; children will learn about Queen Victoria's visit to the Mount; write their own narrative and a witness statement.

Maths - We are studying fractions and multiplication and division. One lesson a week will be based on the four operations. The other maths sessions will cover reasoning and problem solving.

Games Afternoon/PE - This term we are visiting the gym every Monday. On Wednesday in games session the children will be doing netball. After half term, we will be looking at dance from around the world in PE.

History - During the course of this term we are discussing the expansion and separation of the British Empire and how we influenced and impacted the countries we went to.

Geography - We are learning how to use and recognise maps and atlases.

Music - We will be learning how to make music with our bodies and learning about drumming from around the world.

Art and Design - We are studying the work of a famous Victorian artist 'Fanny Eaton'. In DT the children will design and build their own ships.

Computing - We are learning how to stay safe online as well as improving our coding skills.

RE - This term we will be looking at and answering the following two questions: Why do Christians believe Jesus was the Messiah?
Why is the Torah so important to Jewish people?

PSHE - This term we will look at aspirations, how to achieve goals and understanding the emotions that go with this and being and keeping safe and healthy.

Home Learning

Children are expected to read for twenty minutes at home every evening after school. The children should record this in their homework diary, but it needs to be signed by an adult.

Weekly spellings are in homework diaries. Our spelling tests take place on a Monday.
