For the summer term our **Share Your Views** (SYV) board continues to focus on our beautiful, diverse and happy curriculum. <u>Hedgerow Safety</u>

Now that the weather has been sunny the hedgerows are blossoming with all sorts of wonderful flowers. Lots of us love to pick flowers, including picking them for making potions. Please remember that our lovely Cornish hedgerows include foxgloves, which are poisonous and can make us very poorly so if touched hands must be washed. We must never pick these. Also, hogweed has white flowers, which when touched or pressed causes an oil / liquid (sap) to be released that can cause very serious burns to the skin. This sap is in the stalks and leaves rather that the flower. Please see the photos sent out electronically to this newsletter as a reminder of what foxgloves and hogweed look like.
