# Safeguarding Awareness for Parents & Carers

The Importance of Safer Internet Day – the question about the Safer Internet Day for some readers will be 'Why is it important?' or 'Is it not just another awareness day?' the answer is no. The Safer Internet Day has had real world impacts, that have affected millions of children in the past. Safer Internet Day 2022 reached 54% of young people in the UK, resulted in the enlistment of 3,424 supporters and 125,675 downloads of educational resources packs. Last year they also managed to get their videos viewed by just shy of a million people. In addition to this they also pushed #SaferInternetDay to the top of the twitter trending chart for the day. A major success by any measure. But its real successes were more complex, and you can read all about those in the 2022 Impact Report.
