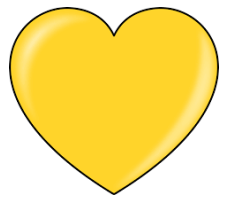

Please can you make sure that you are monitoring your child's use of social media, ensuring that their activity online is age appropriate and responsible. We are running extra circle times in KS2 over the next few weeks with a focus on peer pressure; how to stay safe and be responsible / respectful online; awareness of the effects of social media.
