Breakfast Club (BC) Costs from September 2025

Following feedback from parents and governors and, after discussion with colleagues at Crofty Education Trust, we are now keeping costs for Breakfast Club the same from 1^{st} September 2025 @ £2 per day/per child and free for pupil premium children. During September, there will be a consultation about changes to BC costs, with new costs coming into effect from the start of the second half of the autumn term.

Arbor - Parent Communication

A reminder that we are now ready to start using the Arbor Parent Portal and Parent App. Initially, we will use this for communicating with you through in-app messages and emails. You will also be able to update the data we have through the App instead of having to talk directly to the school office. In the future we will look at other areas that we can use e.g. booking parental consultations. To finish creating your account you just need to set a password. Marazion School Leave of Absence Requests during Term Time

A reminder that, from 1st September 2025, penalty notices will be issued for any unauthorised term time leave (holidays taken in school time) of 5 days (10 sessions) or more. A letter regarding the legal situation is attached to this newsletter with further information. The letter has also been emailed to parents/carers. Please note that requests for term time leave must be requested on the CET (Crofty Education Trust) leave of absence form. The latest attendance guidance states that the Department for Education (DfE) no longer allows Headteachers to grant any leave of absence during term time unless there are exceptional circumstances. The DfE does not consider a need or desire for a holiday or other absence for the purpose of leisure and recreation to be an exceptional circumstance. If leave is not authorised and you nevertheless withdraw your child from school, the absence will be recorded as unauthorised absence.

Safeguarding Awareness for Parents & Carers

Breathing Exercise Guide - Education Support. One way to improve your coping skills when you are in a challenging environment, or if you feel stressed, is breathing. Breathing exercises reduce your fight or flights response by lowering stress hormones like cortisol and adrenaline. Better managing the physical causes of these issues, allows for the restoration of control and improves mental resilience. The speed of a situation can be radically slowed through allowing the brain to take charge. This allows response mechanisms to be well thought through, rather than the physical knee-jerk reaction, which can sometimes drive behaviours.
