2023 Marazion School Residential Visits

A reminder that our 2023 residential visits are now booked. Year 6 are visiting London from Tuesday 14th to Friday 17th March. Year 5 are going off grid at Camp Kernow from Monday 24th April to Wednesday 26th April.
