# Kings Curriculum Information Summer Term 2022



### This term's learning...Bright Futures Start Here! Key Question: What difference does it make?

This term's learning focuses on our school tagline: Bright Futures Start Here. It is a PSHE based topic with a focus on careers and future opportunities in the wider world. Our topic launch, taking place in w/c 16<sup>th</sup> May, is a Pathway to Professions Careers Week - pupils are meeting inspirational members of the workforce; conducting online personality activities and researching different jobs and careers, which they would be interested in pursuing in the future. We hope to be visiting further education sites and workplaces during this week too. In Literacy we are studying a variety of genres including poetry linked to climate change, debate texts about professional leadership and information texts about apprenticeships and universities.

Maths lessons this term are covering various mathematical strands including algebra, ratio and proportion and statistics. We are also recapping the mathematical strands of addition, subtraction, multiplication and division throughout this term. All of our maths lessons will contain fluency, problem solving and reasoning.

In our **Games Afternoon** and **PE** sessions we are learning the sports of Tag American Football, Volleyball, Gymnastics and Basketball.

Our **Geography** focus this term is climate change and the impact increased greenhouse gases have had on our planet. We are looking to find potential solutions to the climate crisis and create our own climate change documentary. In **Science** lessons this term we are learning about electricity. We are drawing and creating circuits using bulbs, buzzers and cells.

In **Music** we are developing our chord knowledge to play a wider range of ensemble songs on the Ukulele. We are also working with Sam to develop our own songs to perform as part of the summer production.

In **Art and Design** we are creating powerful posters to campaign against the causes of climate change, inspired by some of our ex-pupils who had their posters displayed at the COP26, in 2021.

In **Computing** we are learning how to stay safe and respectful whilst online and further developing coding skills.

The **RE** focus this term, we are learning about Hinduism and how Hindus put their beliefs into practice in different ways.

We are also continuing our **Relationships**, **Health and Sex Education (RHSE)** this term. We are discussing what a caring friendship looks like, pregnancy to birth and how to be respectful and safe online.

# **Home Learning**

Children are expected to read for twenty minutes at home every evening after school. The children should record this in their homework diary.

Weekly spellings are given out on Fridays and will be tested the following Friday.
