Our Governing Body is committed to and passionate about providing the very best education for pupils at Marazion School. They both support and challenge the school, holding senior leaders to account. Recently the governors have:

- Continued to deal with a range of post pandemic issues in school
- Continued to manage a high level of staff absence/child absence
- Continued to work remotely where it is more effective and efficient
- Continued to work as an associate partner with Leading Edge Academy Trust (LEAP)
- Managed industrial action by teaching staff, including quality assuring risk assessments for the partial opening of Marazion School
- Reviewed school policies and recommended them to Full Governing Board (FGB) for approval
- Closed down the 2022-2023 budget and set the budget for 2023-2024
- Attended training: Prevent training; DSL update: sexual violence and domestic abuse training; online safety training; DSL update: Virtual School training; SCR audit training; NSPCC keeping children safe online; site managers' course; chair training; new governor inductions; spring safeguarding update
- Carried out governor monitoring visits remotely and/or face to face
- Involved in the organisation and management of the development of the Marazion School site, working with a range of other agencies
- Researching possibilities for green energy, including the installation of solar panels.
