Equipment Needed

Children are required to wear full PE kit to school for their PE sessions on Monday and Friday.

Deltas Class Curriculum Information Summer 2024



This term's learning

Key Question: Where is home?

Our topic for this term is migration. This is a geography-based topic. To launch this topic, we are participating in 'Skathow', a project by Tough Dough and Wildworks Theatre. Skathow is inspired by tales of Celtic pilgrims from Ireland who carried their boats from Hayle Estuary to Marazion to avoid the perilous journey around Lands End. This project involves a day with some local artists creating boats and a day at the beach participating in activities with children from a school in Hayle.

In **Literacy** we are covering a range of genres linked to our topic including non-chronological reports about animal migration, newspaper stories, diary entries and letters.

In **Maths** sessions, we are looking at: decimals, percentages, shape and statistics. We are focussing on fluency in these areas as well as improving our reasoning and problem-solving skills.

PE - we are working on a range of invasion sports such as tennis, cricket, and gymnastics. We are also trying out athletics in preparation for Sports Day.

History - we are learning about migration stories including European Jews fleeing to the USA to escape religious discrimination and Vietnamese people who travelled in makeshift boats to escape from the Communist regime as well as Cornish miners who migrated across the world.

Science - we are learning about the life cycles of plants, living things and their habitats and continuing our learning linked to Relationship, Health and Sex Education (RHSE).

Geography - we are comparing different geographical areas, describing key aspects of human and physical geography and learning about volcanoes and earthquakes.

Music - we are learning to play within a samba band and are learning and singing songs for our Summer Production.

Art and Design - we are creating boats as part of the 'Skathow' project, and learning to create designs with batik.

Computing - we are learning how to stay safe online and making and editing short videos.

RE - we are learning about the Jewish faith, the Torah and Jewish synagogues.

Home Learning

Your child has a reading record where you can record their daily reading. Your child can write in this themselves, but it needs to be signed by an adult.

As well as daily reading, your child will receive weekly spellings and times tables.

These are tested on a Monday. We practise these in school, but it is essential to your child's progress and confidence to practise them at home too. We stick the spellings into your child's reading record weekly. They can practise on paper or online on 'Spelling Shed'
