


MARAZION SCHOOL NEWSLETTER 14th September 2023

Dear Parents,

It can be tricky deciding whether or not to keep your child off school when they're unwell. There are government guidelines for schools (and nurseries) about <u>managing specific infectious diseases at GOV.UK</u>. These say when children should be kept off school and when they shouldn't. A reminder that, if you do keep your child at home, you must phone school on each day of their absence and let us know that your child won't be in school and give us the reason. You can speak to Ed or Tamsyn in the office or leave a message - we have an automated service, press 1 for the absence line.

Big Dig - TOMORROW Friday 15th September

We are taking part in a Big Dig tomorrow, working in groups to do a woodland clean and prepare the school site for autumn planting and growing. Children in Curious Clouds and Rivers are doing their Big Dig in the morning and KS2 children in the afternoon. Recently we have harvested beetroot, courgettes, melons and beans as well as sweet peas from our kitchen garden. The fruit and vegetables were used in the canteen for school lunches, and we sold some bunches of sweet peas at the end of the school day.

Our autumn parents' meetings are focused on getting to know each other, finding out about school and classroom routines and having a snack, a cup of tea and a catch up.
