Safeguarding Awareness for Parents & Carers

Washing Pods and Capsules - Child Accident Prevention Trust. Young children are vulnerable to all sorts of dangers in the home. One of the issues can come in the form of everyday cleaning products, for example, some sink unclogger can look like fruit juice. However, one threat stands out from all others - the washing pod. Many washing pods bear a striking similarity to sweets. For children the mistake can be easy to make, especially when washing pods may be kept in a lower location than other cleaning supplies.
