# 2025 Residential Visits

Year 4/5 Residential Visit: Children in Year 4 and 5 are off to Camp Kernow from Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> to Friday 20<sup>th</sup> June. A Parents' Meeting for this residential visit is in school next Tuesday 29<sup>th</sup> April (straight after school). Year 6 Oxford Residential Visit: A reminder that children in Year 6 are visiting Oxford, a university town, from Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> May to Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> May. Parental consent forms were sent out yesterday and need to be returned to school by Tuesday 6<sup>th</sup> May.

# Inset Days 2025-26

Marazion School inset days for next year are: Monday 1<sup>st</sup> September; Monday 20<sup>th</sup> - Friday 24<sup>th</sup> October; Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> March and Monday 1<sup>st</sup> June.

Next year, Marazion School is having a 2 week break over the October half term. This has been achieved by taking an inset day for staff training in the school holidays (on 1<sup>st</sup> September); children returning to school in September a day early (on 2<sup>nd</sup> September) and adding an additional day to the end of the summer term (Friday 24<sup>th</sup> July). We are also using 2 training days, which staff will work as 'twilight' training, which is after 5pm. Overall, the number of days the school is open to children has not changed. This pattern of term dates has been used really successfully by a number of primary and secondary schools in Cornwall and other local authorities. We plan to review this pattern during the 2025-26 school year before deciding on our dates for the following year.
