Coronavirus Behaviour Policy Appendix

Coronavirus Behaviour Principles

Arriving/leaving school:

- The start/end to the school day is the same: 8.45am-3.00pm
- Some classes continue to use different entrances into and exits from school
- Some pupils may still arrive/leave school independently (with parents' signed permission)
- Children and families walk/bike/scoot the last part of their journey to school

Cleaning and Hygiene:

- There is a daily list of daily thorough cleaning that needs to be done in school – see Annex A
- Children must wash their hands-on arrival at school
- Children must wash their hands after every session and before and after eating
- Children must wash their hands after using any equipment
- Children must practise good respiratory hygiene - Catch It; Bin It; Kill It - by coughing/sneezing into their elbow and, when using tissues, putting their used tissues immediately into a lidded bin
- Children must use the 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach – cough/sneeze into your elbow or use a tissue. You must put any used tissues immediately into a lidded bin
- Children must not cough, sneeze or spit towards any other person
- Children can bring their own packed lunch or can order a hot/cold school lunch provided by school. **Please note that both universal free school meal children (Year R, 1 and 2) and free school meal (FSM) children are eligible for a free school lunch.**

Contact with children and adults:

- Children must tell an adult if they are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus in school
- Parents must inform school if any member of their family is experiencing symptoms of coronavirus
- Parents must inform school immediately if there is a confirmed positive case of COVID 19 in any of their household and/or close contacts. They must then self-isolate for 10 days, unless they are fully vaccinated
- If any parent/child has a positive test result for coronavirus, they must self-isolate for 10 days.

September 2021

- Marazion School will provide remote learning for any children who have to self-isolate

Equipment and resources

- Primary school children do not need to wear a face covering
- Children must wear school uniform
- Children must come to school wearing PE kit on PE days
- Equipment and resources will continue to be thoroughly cleaned regularly
- The Marazion curriculum remains broad, balanced and ambitious
- In the event of a localised / national lockdown or for pupils who are having to self-isolate there is a high-quality remote learning offer
- Remote learning offer includes Seesaw/Zoom/Teams, with a combination of 'live' and pre-recorded sessions

Please note that the Marazion School Rewards and Sanction System is still applied consistently across the school and children may be faced with a fixed term exclusion if they persistently ignore these behaviour principles.

Please also note that some children may have an individual risk assessment that identifies any reasonable, safe adjustments that need to be made. This risk assessment must be signed by both staff and parents.
